COMPETITION REQUIREMENTS

- *Competition classes will be different from past seasons. This season, Miss Emily will be placing students in dance routines based on individual style and experience.*
- *Students in 2nd-6th Grade must take either Ballet or Jazz dance class to compete and 7th through 12th Grade students must take the Competition Technique class.*
- *Competitive dancers will pay \$200.00 for the competition season which includes only ONE competition entry fee. 7th through 12th Grade competitive dancers will pay an additional \$100.00 for the competition technique class.*
- *Competitive dancers of all ages must complete at least seven hours of dance at Rockport Dance Academy over the summer in order to join the 2015-2016 competition team.*
